# College Goal Georgia FAFSA Completion Guidelines for Participating Organizations



## 1. Purpose

- i. The College Goal Georgia (CGG) FAFSA Completion initiative, is sponsored by the [Georgia Student Finance Commission](#) (GSFC). It is a FREE event where selected schools and volunteers help students and families who need assistance in completing their FAFSA, with a particular focus on helping low-income, first-generation families. The federal government requires a FAFSA from all students seeking financial aid to pay for college, such as Pell Grants and federal student loans.

## 2. Supporting the Program

- i. The success of the program depends in part on support from the communities in which it takes place. This support is from non-profit entities, businesses and individuals who support the educational and charitable mission of the program. Supporters are invited, and encouraged to contribute, subject to the following:
- ii. The name and identity of CGG FAFSA Completion must be protected. A funder may not be the exclusive, or sole, supporter of CGG FAFSA Completion nor may a supporter state or imply ownership or control of the CGG FAFSA Completion name or program.
- iii. Supporters of CGG FAFSA Completion will be recognized as being a contributor to the program through listings in promotional materials if applicable.
- iv. Support of CGG FAFSA Completion activities is not intended to represent a business development or marketing opportunity, nor may support of CGG FAFSA Completion be used to further a political agenda, candidate, position or platform.
- v. CGG FAFSA Completion supporters are expected to have missions that are consistent with and in furtherance of that of CGG FAFSA Completion, and operate in a fashion that is consistent with prevailing community standards.
- vi. Support for CGG is deductible as a charitable contribution to the extent provided by law.

### 3. Use of the College Goal Georgia Name

- i. To protect the College Goal Georgia FAFSA Completion name and to ensure consistency in communications efforts, all CGG FAFSA Completion programs will adhere to the following:
- ii. In all informational materials, organizations are asked to use the service marks symbol (<sup>SM</sup>) after the first textual reference to College Goal Georgia FAFSA Completion. Subsequent references need not carry the mark.

### 4. The College Goal Georgia FAFSA Completion program was created by the Georgia Student Finance Commission.

- i. The CGG FAFSA Completion logo may not be used in conjunction with *any* materials that advertise or promote a supporting organization or its business activities.
